Page 8	Line 110 should read: 110 LET X=640:LET Y=360
Page 8	Line 10000 should read line 1000
Page 11	Line 270 should read: 270 IF ARRAY(Y) > BIG THEN LET BIG=ARRAY(Y)
Page 38	Section 'The Word Processor'. Insert the following text between paragraph 3 and paragraph 4: 'If you have redefined part or all of the character set (see page 105), these definitions will be retained when you enter the word processor. To revert to the original characters type CLEAR FONT and press 'enter' before leaving BASIC.'
Page 41	Section 'Saving Text on Cassette'. Paragraph 2, line 3, should read: '... press the 'record' and 'play' buttons ...'
