This machine is available to you on a loan basis for the purpose of evaluation for software origination, and will remain the property of Enterprise Computers Ltd.

In order to supply machines for initial training purposes, the product that you have received has not been put through the full quality control cycle during manufacturing. Hence, it is not suitable for bench test evaluation by the press and retailers and so must not be offered to any person outside of your programming staff. We will obviously require maximum confidentiality during these early stages of product availability.

Enclosed with the computer is a technical information manual, setting-up guide and all necessary leads. There is also a description of how to change the bias of the video chip between 256 colour and 80 column mode. This procedure will not be necessary on final production units.
